
We are happy to report that once again, Felix Cruz will provide us

CHICKEN SAUSAGE CACCIATORE

Now that the holiday season is over, here is an easy crockpot recipe I am sure you all will like.

- 1 large green pepper sliced into 1" strips
- 1 cup of sliced mushrooms
- 1 medium onion sliced in rings
- 1 lb. of Italian sausage (browned)
- 1 lb. of skinless, boneless chicken breasts (browned)
- 1/2 tsp. dried oregano
- 1/2 tsp. dried basil
- 1 1/2 cups of Italian tomato sauce

Layer veg. in crockpot. Top with meat. Sprinkle with oregano and basil. Top with tomato sauce. Cover & cook on low for 8 hrs.

Remove cover during last 30 minutes of cooking time to allow sauce to cook-off and thicken. Serve over spiral pasta.

Please pay at the January meeting or send to our mailbox if you cannot make the meeting. The address is noted here.






and bite size cakes. OMG! enough said. There were raffles for prizes galore. Chris Barrett and Marlene Bretl were among the winners- Congrats.

Display Entries

Base Size: No less than 2 x 2 feet and no more than 3 x 4 feet.

Lighted Buildings: Made only by Department 56.

Accessories: Any source.

Must be an actual display, which has been constructed and photographed.

Must be the work of one person, not a team.

Entry forms: At NCC56.com; VillageD-Lights.com; 800.352.8039 ext. 15

Individual entries submitted to a Club will have:

A) 6-12 high resolution (300 dpi) digital files/photos, showing the progression for building the display, accompanied by descriptions for each photo (no more than 100 words each),

B) 2-3 image file(s) of the completed display at its best, and

C) Entry Form with the Club name and a 100-word Bio and Photo of the display builder.

VOTING: Out of more than 100 possible NCC club entries, the top 10 winners will be chosen by a panel of judges. These top 10 then will be pictured in a public voting ballot in the Village D-Lights April/May 2011 issue. Readers will vote for the top two by fax, email, or US mail. All voting will close May 15.


