

During our last board meeting, we discussed producing, a 2013 Village Landlords Open House Calendar. What better way to highlight our hobby year round. More information to come at the next meeting!


As our Facebook page continues to grow, I know that some of you haven't had the opportunity to visit our page yet! So I thought I would recap the page and all of

- We have also added photographs from our February Meeting / Swap & Sell. Be sure to check out the tables of merchandise and everyone in action.




As you can see, we have had a very busy month. If anyone has anything they would like to include, please let


