




Calendars, Open Houses, Autographs!





Texas Sheet Cake from Betty Hargrave

Mix in bowl 2 cups of sugar, 2 cups of flour, $\frac{1}{2}$ t of salt, 1 teaspoon of soda. In separate bowl, mix 2 eggs, $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of sour cream, 1 teaspoon of vanilla. In pan mix 2 sticks of oleo, 1 cup of water, 4 tablespoons of Nestle Quick. Mix flour mixture with chocolate mixture, then add egg mixture. Beat well. Pour into a greased jelly roll pan. Bake at 400 degrees for 20 minutes.

Frosting-1 stick of oleo or butter, 4 tablespoons Nestle Quick, 6 tablespoons of Pet Milk. Add 1 box of confectioner's sugar and 1 teaspoon of vanilla. Beat until smooth. Pour over hot cake. YUM!
