Was that a great picnic or what? Aside from a little breeze, which made the temperature comfortable, it was a perfect day, good food, good friends, great games and lots of laughter.

For our April meeting I hope to duplicate some of that. **Bob Obenland** and I have put together a “make and take” that I am sure you will find fun as well as interesting. We will be making walls that are made from ceiling tiles. I have broken the tiles into 2” x 24” pieces, each person will receive 4 of these pieces. I would like every single member to take 4 pieces. When that is satisfied we will pass out 1 extra piece to each couple until all pieces are gone.

You may assemble the pieces several different ways. We will offer some ideas but I am positive some of you can come up with more ideas of your own. We will “hot glue” the pieces together. Once done, we can paint your creation in several different ways. Because we will be working with some “messy” mediums, I would strongly recommend wearing something that is not your finest. The paint is washable. An apron covering your front would also be advisable.

I have put together a sample of what you can make using this method. I have painted it using two different color schemes to show you some possibilities. See pictures.

I think it will be fun so let’s look forward to our last meeting until September!

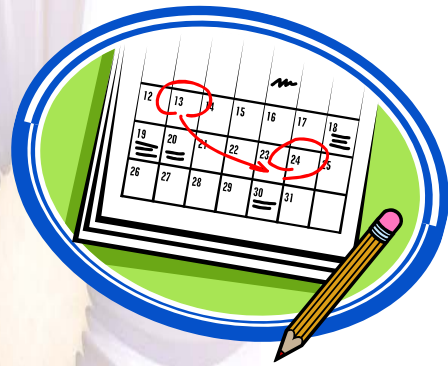

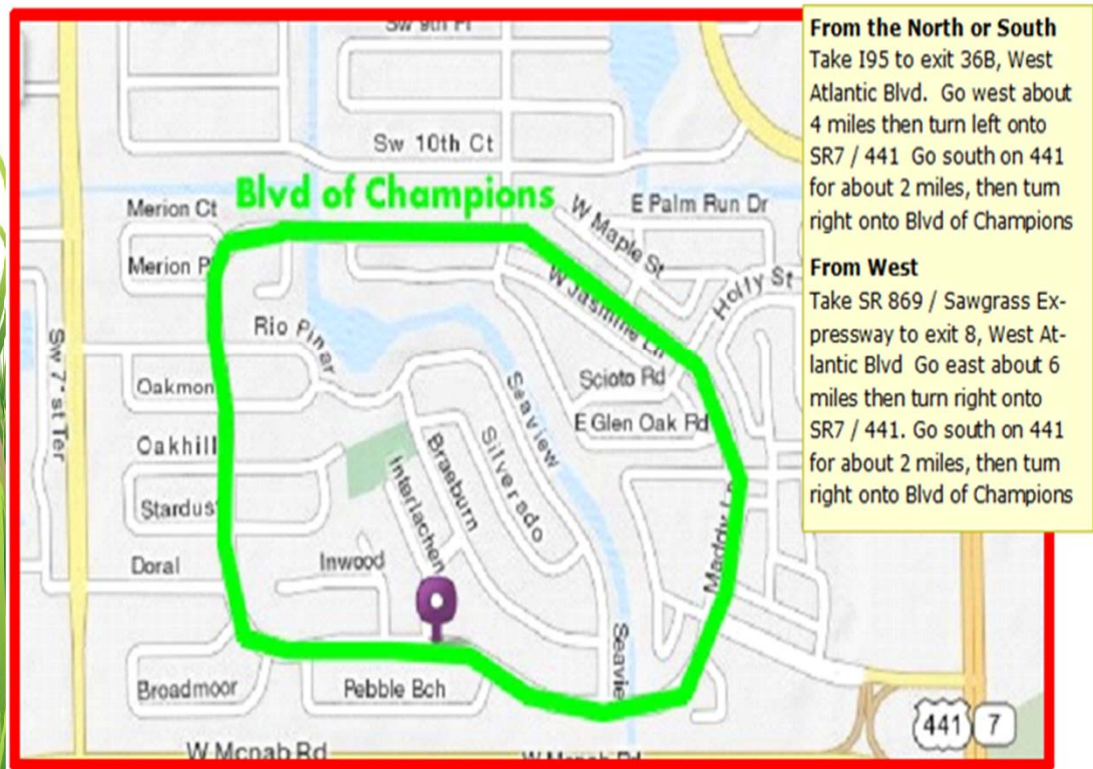

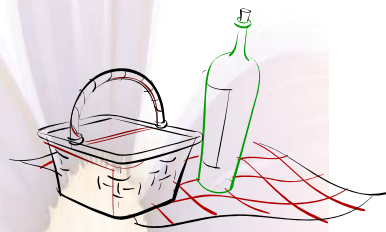
