A Recipe from Chris' Kitchen...



Sweet and Sour Cucumbers and Onions
From Chris Barrett

5 cucumbers (I use the long seedless ones)
1 large or 2 small onions (depending on how much you like)
1 cup white vinegar
3/4 cup sugar
Peel and slice cucumbers into thin slices.
Squeeze the cucumbers to take the water out of them. Do this a few times. I also put the slices between paper towels and pound or use a rolling pin.
Peel and slice onions into half rings.
Mix cucumbers and onions in large bowl.
Heat vinegar so it is hot enough to dissolve sugar.
Pour the sweet/sour vinegar over the cucumbers and onions. Mix and let stand overnight. You can add more vinegar or sugar depending on taste.

I can't believe this is our last meeting!

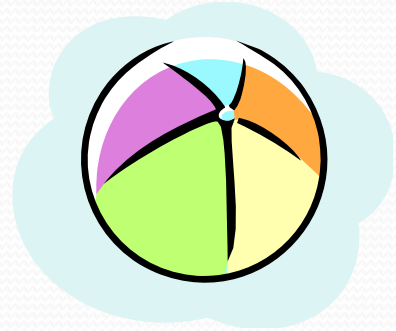

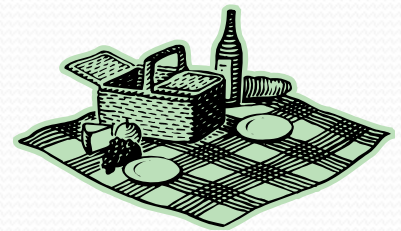

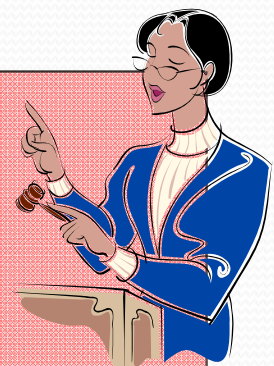
