

#### **BOOZE MEATBALLS**

This is really a slow-cooker recipe, but who wants to wait that long!

For every 1 lb. of meatballs.....

1 lb. cooked meatballs (Armour, etc.)

1/2 cup Apple Jelly

1/8 cup Dijon Mustard

1/8 cup Jack Daniels (or Scotch Whiskey, or WHATEVER!!!

(don't forget a **BIG** splash for the cook)

Splashes of Worcestershire Sauce

While heating meatballs thoroughly in the oven, mix jelly, mustard, and booze in large saucepan and simmer. (This melts the jelly but gets rid of the alcohol).

Drain juices from meatballs and add to sauce. Mix thoroughly to coat meatballs. Splash some Worcestershire sauce and mix again. Splash on some more Worcestershire sauce and hand out the toothpicks (so one can only take a few meatballs at a time). **ENJOY!**


### **Notes from your Editor:**
