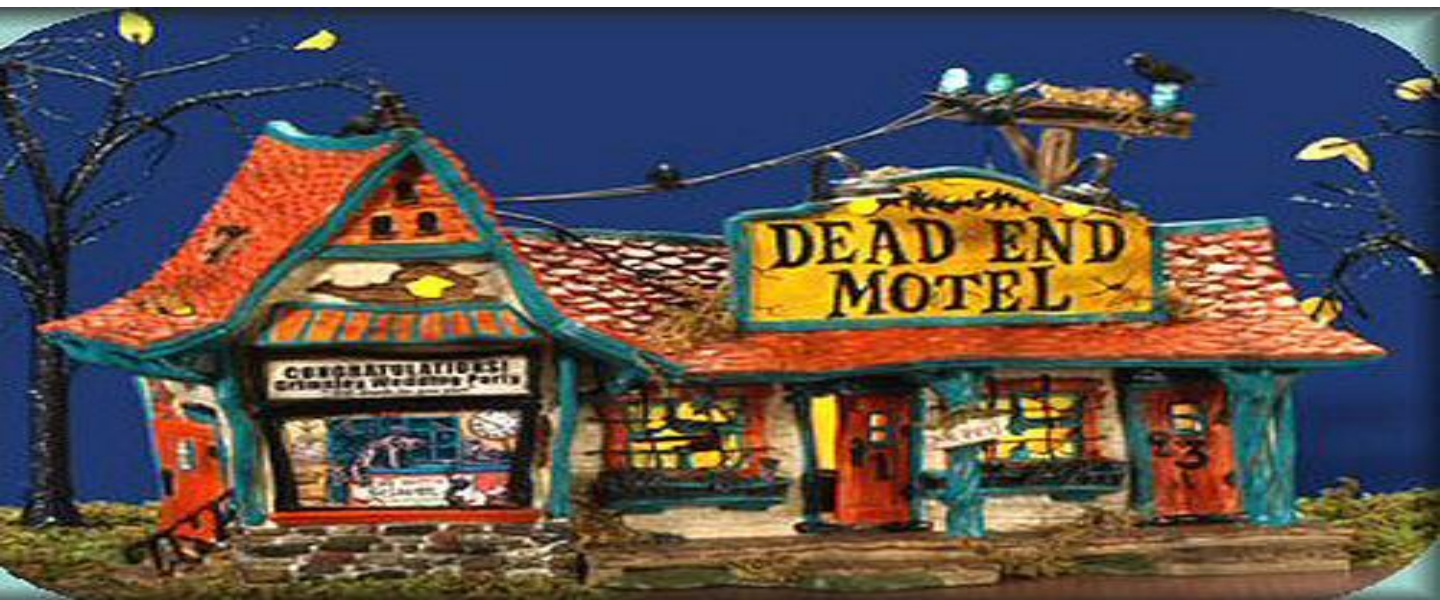
Joe McPhillips called the meeting to order at 2:45 pm. He welcomed a new member, Rich Landry. **WELCOME!**

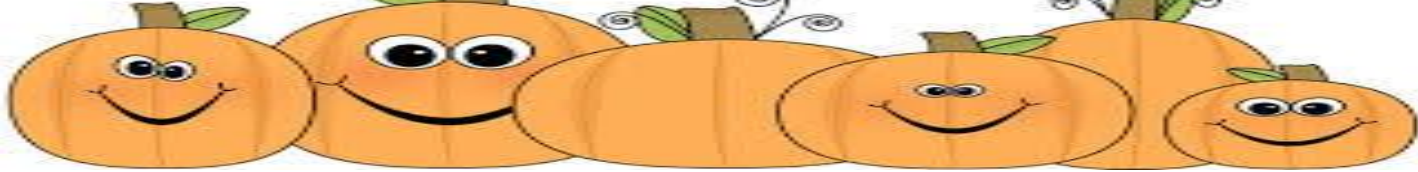

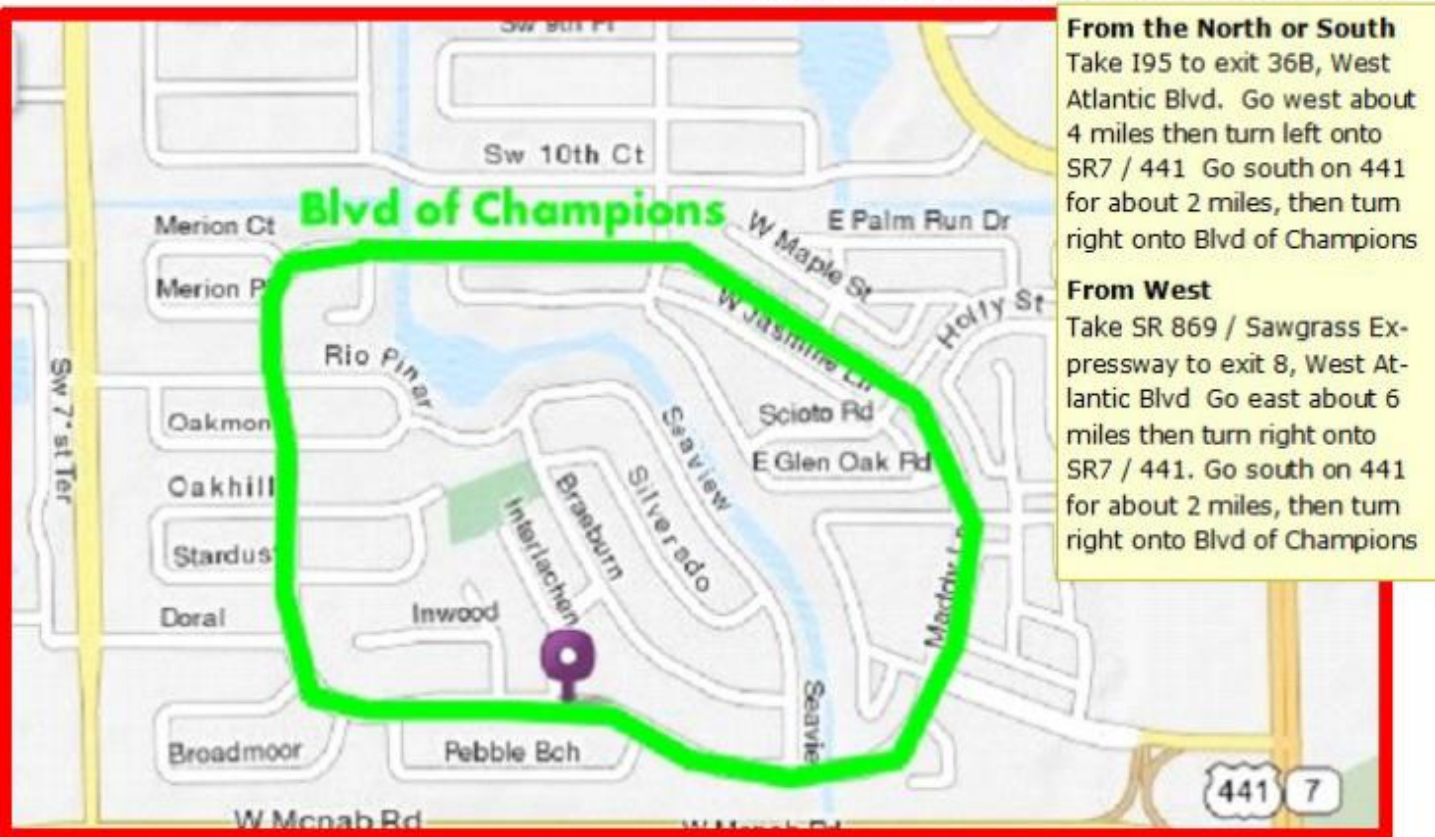

6601 Blvd of Champions, North Lauderdale, FL 33068



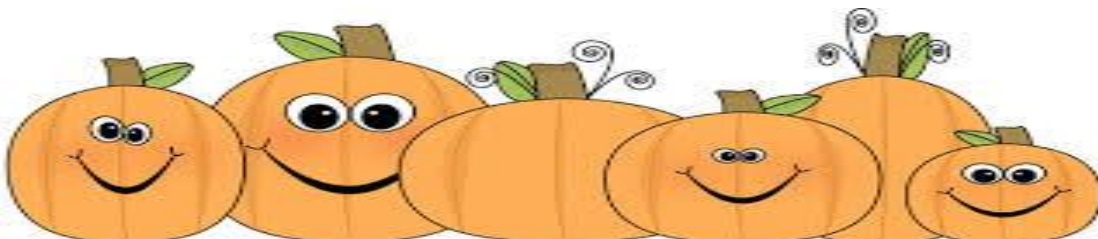
From the North or South
