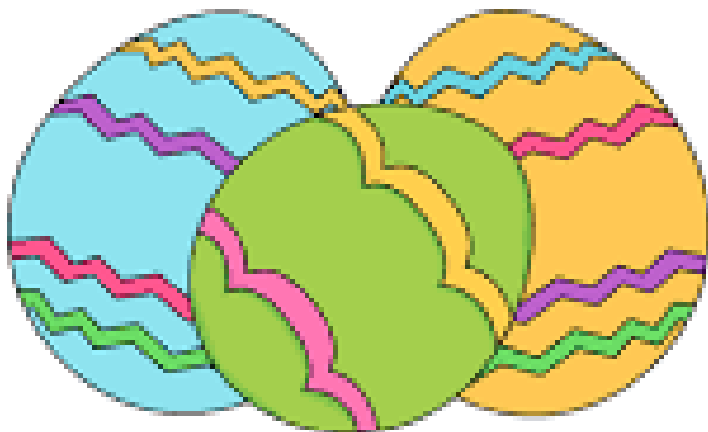

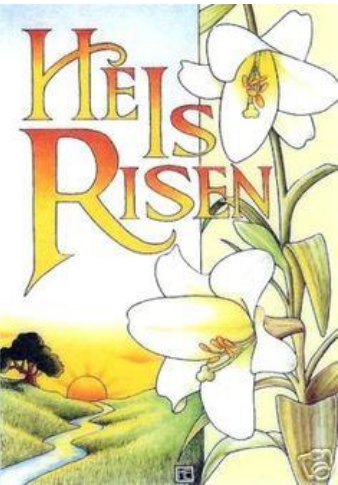
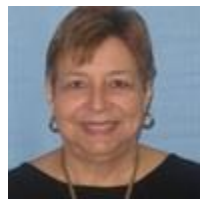

## A Note from the Editor...Gisela Suarez



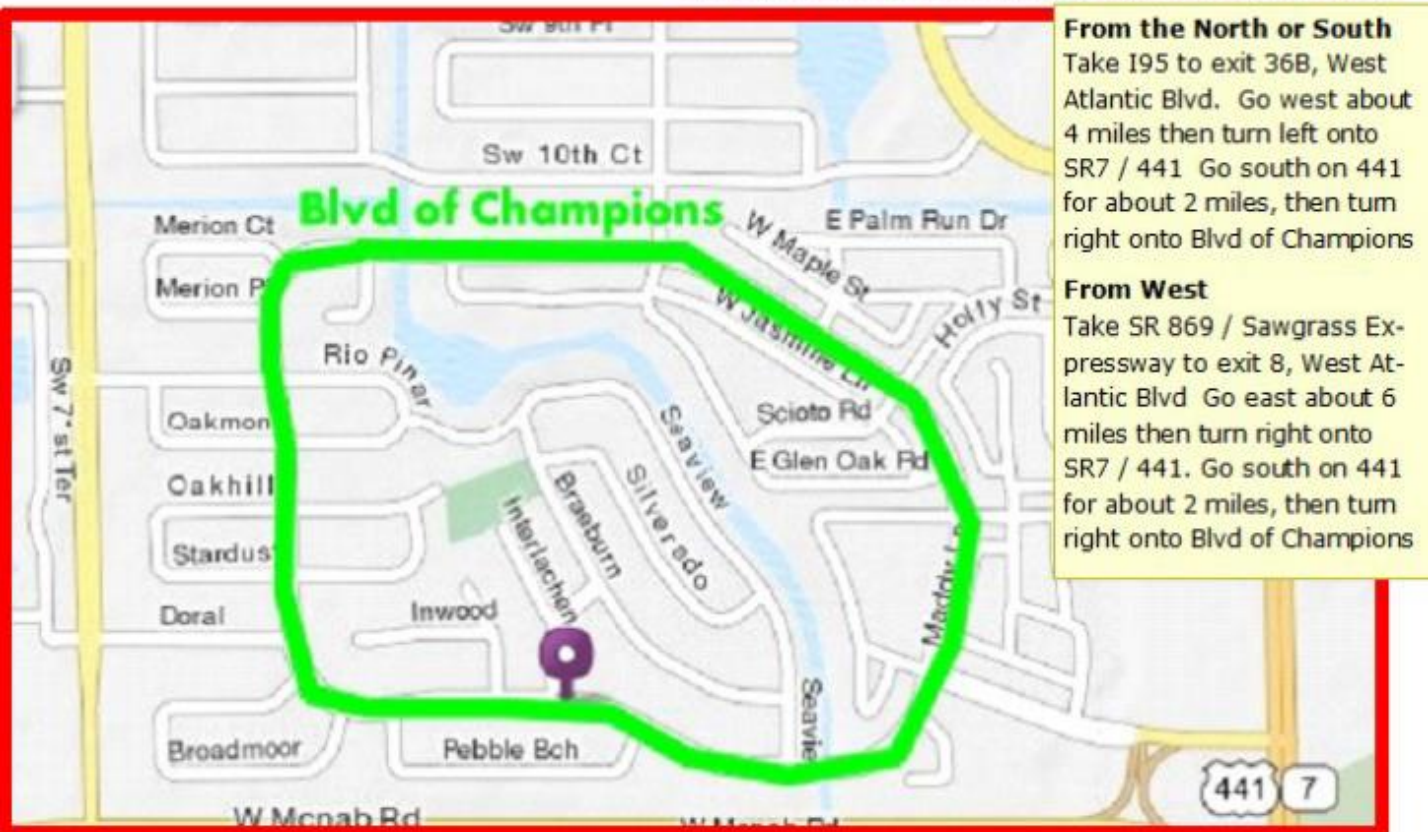

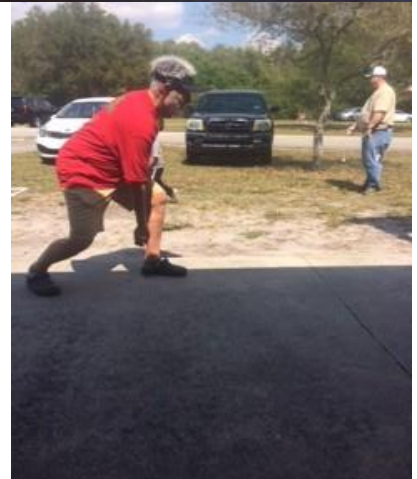
### **From West**
