A motion to adjourn was made at 4:30 pm by Norm Barrett, seconded by Eileen O'Connor. The motion carried.



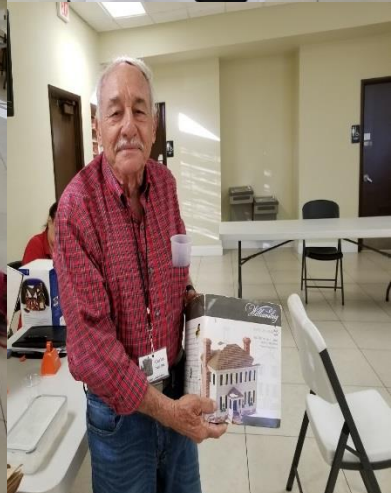

Recipe of the Month - Courtesy of Kathy Kirouac

15 Beans Soup - Kathy delighted us with this soup at the October meeting

What you need: 2 packages of 15 Beans (Cajun);
1 large onion (chopped); 1 bunch of scallions (chopped);
6 stalks of celery (chopped); 4 tablespoons minced garlic; 1 large green pepper and 1 large red pepper (chopped); a can whole kernel corn (salt free); 1 tablespoon black pepper; 1 can green beans; 2 - 28 oz cans crushed tomatoes; 2 cans Italian style diced tomatoes; 2 packages chopped ham; 4 packages of sliced Hillshire Polka Kielbasa; 1 bag spinach, 3 tablespoons each of basil, marjoram, oregano, parsley, rosemary, thyme, Italian blend and seasoned salt; 1 tablespoon chili powder.

INSTRUCTIONS: Cooking time for this recipe is 5 to 6 hours. In a large pot, in plenty of water, cook the beans in HIGH for at for 45 minutes. Then add all the ingredients up to the spinach. Keep cooking. Every 1 ½ hours (approximately 3 times during the cooking period) add 1 tablespoon of all the other ingredients, except the chili powder. Add the chili powder one time only during the last 1 ½ hour of cooking.



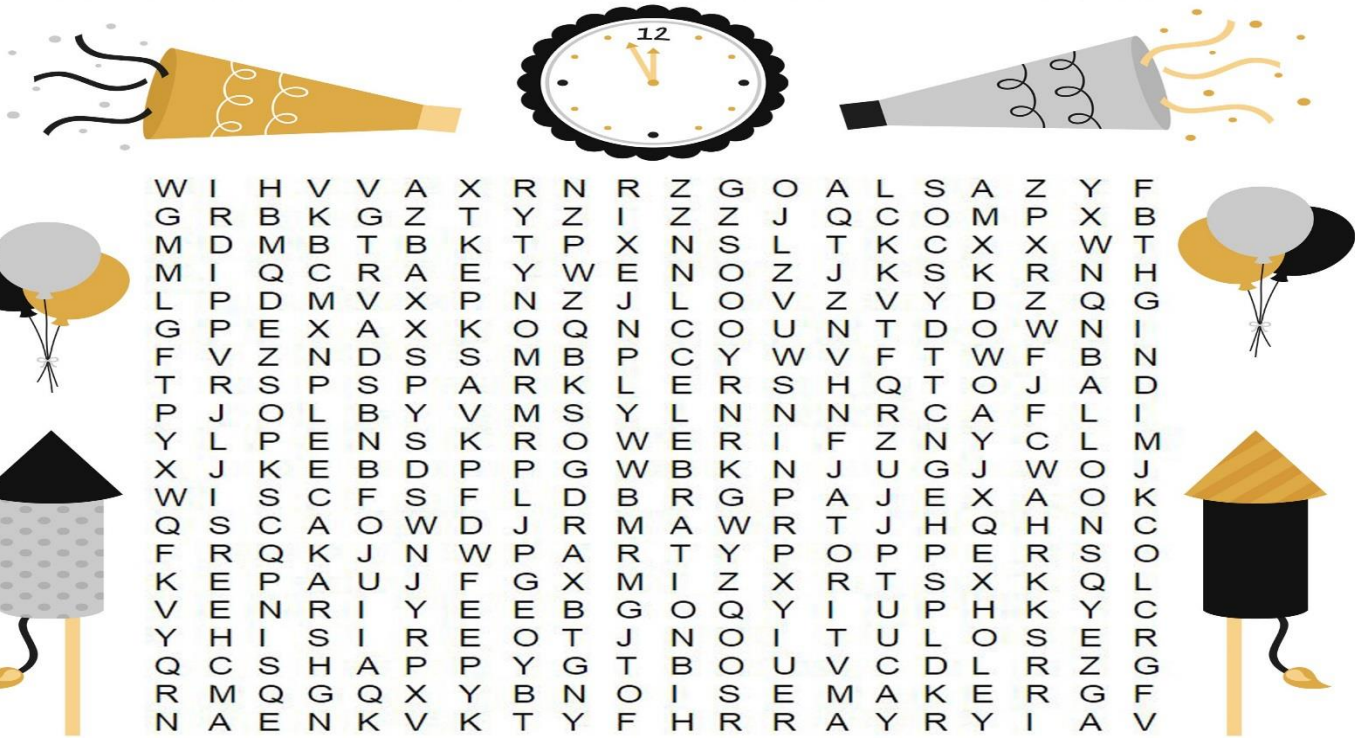
