As promised, here is a new recipe for your to enjoy. tried the recipe myself, and it is easy and delicious. It is the perfect dinner for a hot Florida day.



GREEK PASTA SALAD

Ingredients:

1 lb. farfalle pasta

3 tbsp red wine vinegar

½ tsp garlic powder

½ red onion

2 tsp dill, finely chopped

1/3 cup Kalamata olives

pitted and chopped

1/4 cup olive oil

½ tsp dried oregano

1 large cucumber, chopped

1 cup cherry tomatoes, halved

½ cup crumbled Feta cheese

salt and black pepper to taste

NOTE: I substituted the Kalamata olives (which I don't like) with black olives. I did not have cherry tomatoes, therefore, I removed the seeds from three medium size Rome tomatoes and chopped them.

Directions:

- 1. In a large pot of salted boiling water, cook farfalle until al dente. Drain and transfer to a large serving bowl and cool to room temperature. (to save time
- 2. In a serving bowl, whisk together the olive oil, red wine vinegar, oregano and and garlic powder.
- 3. To the serving bowl, add the cucumbers, tomatoes, olives, onions and pasta. Toss until evenly coated. Season with salt and pepper to your taste, add dill and feta cheese on top. ENJOY!!!


