
DRACULAS DENTURES

INGREDIENTS

1 tube chocolate chip cookie dough

1 can vanilla frosting red food coloring mini marshmallows slivered almonds





DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat oven to 350°. Line two large baking sheets with parchment paper. Roll cookie dough into 1 ½" balls and place on baking sheets.

2. Bake until golden, about 12 minutes. Let cool completely then cut in half.

3. Add a few drops of red food coloring into vanilla frosting and stir until smooth. Spread a thin layer of red frosting onto each cookie half.

4. Place mini marshmallows around the round edges of half of the halves. Place the remaining halves on top, then stick a slivered almond on each side to create fangs.


Swap and Sell
