# SWEET POTATO CASSEROLE (WITH A TWIST)

#### **INGREDIENTS**:

6 CUPS OF MASHED SWEET POTATOES 2/3 CUPS OF EGG NOG ½ CUP GOLDEN RAISINS 2 TABLESPOONS OF SUGAR 1 TEASPOON SALT

#### **TOPPING:**

- ¼ CUP ALL PURPOSE FLOUR
- 1/4 CUP QUICK COOKING OATS
- ¼ CUP BROWN SUGAR
- ¼ CUP CHOPPED PECANS
- 3 TBS MELTED BUTTER
- 3/4 TSP GROUND CINNAMON
- ¼ TSP GROUND NUTMEG

#### INSTRUCTIONS:


- 1. PREHEAT OVEN TO 350 DEGREES
- 2. IN A LARGE BOWL, COMBINE THE FIRST 5 INGREDIENTS. MIX THEM WELL.
- 2. TRANSFER THE MIX TO A 2 QT. BAKING DISH. FLAT THE TOP.
- 3. MIX ALL OF THE TOPPING INGREDIENTS AND SPRINKLE OVER THE TOP
- 4. BAKE AT 350 DEGREES FOR 30 TO 35 MINUTES.


