
## Chicken Nuggets Parmesan

This is one of those quick, “get me out of trouble” recipes that my children used to love, and I did too. It is good for 4 to 5 servings:

- 20 pieces of store bought frozen chicken nuggets
- ½ cup grated Parmesan Cheese
- 1 tablespoon Italian Seasoning
- 16 oz. Spaghetti Sauce
- 8 oz. Shredded Mozzarella Cheese
- 1 teaspoon olive oil




Unfrost the chicken nuggets. Pre-heat the oven to 375 degrees. Spread the olive oil at the bottom of the baking pan to prevent the chicken from sticking to the pan. Place the chicken nuggets individually in a single layer. Spread the Parmesan cheese freely on it. Sprinkle the Italian Seasoning uniformly over it. Pour the spaghetti sauce evenly over the nuggets and then spread the mozzarella cheese on top. Place the baking pan in the middle of the preheated oven for 30 minutes or longer, until the mozzarella cheese melts to your like. Serve with noodles or spaghetti.




